

Submission Guidelines – Visualisations

ORCA is accepting submissions of data-driven maps and graphs that visualise the rise of China from scholars and young researchers interested in China.

- The topic of the visualisation should be focused on China or a China-related issue.
 Please submit the visualisation as a PNG image format.
- The word length explaining the graph/map should be between 100-200 words detailing the visualisation. Any missing data or anomalies should be mentioned clearly.
- The visualisation should mention the source in a clear and legible manner.
- The ideal dimensions for the visualisation are **1200x700 pixels**.
- If you have a finished visualisation that you are confident fits our requirements, share it with us at <u>writetous.orca@gmail.com</u>.
- While at present we are seeking to commission paid pieces only from senior scholars, if your piece performs well, we may just commission one from you the next time!
- We would also want you to share extensively the visualisations we publish, follow our <u>Twitter</u> and keep tabs on our <u>website</u> to read and review.
- Plagiarism is strictly not-allowed; each submission with be thoroughly checked for the same.
- Visualisations on China's domestic politics are most welcome with proper factchecking.
- When sharing your complete visualisation, please share a **short biography** (approximately 3-4 sentences) and a **formal picture** of yourself along with it.
